Evaluate effectiveness

- How many followup questions (calls and emails) do you get preand postimplementation?
- Measure an outcome of relevance for your target patient population (e.g., HbA1C for patients with diabetes) pre-and postimplementation.
- What is patient satisfaction with teach-back?
- What is clinician satisfaction with teach-back?

Evaluate implementation success

- Do clinicians report using teach-back?
- Do patients report the use of teach-back?
