AHRQ's Core Competencies




- Health Systems Research: Invest in research and evidence to make healthcare safer and improve quality.

- Data & Analytics: Generate measures and data to track and improve performance, and evaluate progress of the US healthcare system.


AHRQ Patient Safety Priorities




- Focus on areas of greatest impact

2019 SOPS Nursing Home Database Report:

Surveys completed between January 2016 and July 2018

191 nursing homes with 10,499 respondents

Top scoring composites measures:

- Overall Perceptions of Resident Safety
- Feedback and Communication About Incidents
- 2020 Database Submission period was postponed
